The sun is our most important star. It can be dangerous to human both here on earth and in outer space. We need to discover all we can about its dangers.

Many stars are larger than our sun. However, the sun is about 250,000 times closer to the earth than any other star. Most of our energy comes from the sun's rays. We can trace electricity, wind, and water power back to the sun.

Not all kinds of solar rays reach the earth. The earth is wrapped in a blanket of air that keeps out dangerous solar rays that might harm us. Now people are exploring space. They are going outside their blankets of air. They have become interested in the dangerous solar rays.

Sometimes there are storms in the sun's hot gases. These storms are called solar flares. During solar flares, the sun produces heavy rays that move at faster speed than usual. The rays can make spacecraft engines break down. They might also make people in space ill or die.

There is no way to tell when a solar flare will take place. Before it is safe for humans to go on long trips through space, we need to know more about solar flares. We must find better ways to protect people from the sun's dangerous rays.
